- f. Merger Options: for St. John Rectory and parking lot. Will It be possible to lease out the rectory to someone like Harvard or tufts?
- g. Where will Fr. Joe be resident, at St. Peter's (assuming he is going to be the pastor of both). What would happen to Fr. Leclerc and to Fr. Lenny O'Malley(St. Peters). If Fr. Joe is not going to be pastor, what does that mean to us?
- h. What are the Haitian community concerns?
- i. What will Fr. Miracles status be?
- j. We will need to communicate with parishioners of both St John and St Peters.
- k. Will need to get a list of emails or home addresses or phone numbers for all parishioners. Maybe set up a phone bank like we did with the Increase Offertory Program.
- I. Do we need to also include St. Peter's team including Father Leonard O'Malley, along with their parish council, finance committee and business manager for their feelings about a merger in the initial meeting.

What about St. Peter's elementary school pre-K through Grade 8 with around 220 students. Do we need to include the school staff in future discussions? Does St. Peter's have a minority community?
