Sunday Readings, Year C:

The **First Reading** is taken from the *Book of Wisdom 9:13-18a*. In today's extract the author is stressing man's incapability of understanding the divine plans and decrees. Because we are finite, limited beings, our knowledge is finite and limited. There are many limited, finite problems all around us, which we cannot solve. How could we hope to solve the infinite ones?

The **Second Reading** is from St. Paul to *Philemon 9b-10, 12-17*. This letter is the shortest of St. Paul's letters and at the same time the most personal and touching. During his first imprisonment in Rome (61-63), a slave called Onesimus, who had run away from his Christian master Philemon, a native of Colossae, came to Paul in Rome and was converted to Christianity. Paul sent him back to his master bearing this letter, in which Paul touchingly appeals to Philemon to deal kindly with the runaway.

The **Gospel** is from *St. Luke 14:25-33* and teaches us that the essential condition for true discipleship, demanded by Christ, was, and still is, total dedication, total commitment of oneself to Him. There can be no such person as a half-Christian. "He that is not with me is against me," He said on another occasion. We cannot be for Christ on Sunday and against Him for the remainder of the week. To be His true disciples, His true followers, we must live our Christian life every day and all day.

Following Christ means making our way to heaven. It is a life-journey. We have a limited time in which to complete this journey. Therefore, we must travel a certain distance each day. This does not mean that we must spend every day in prayer and meditation. There are other tasks to be done, but we must Christianize these other tasks. Even the members of religious orders who "leave the world," that is, who are set free from the family and financial cares of this world by their vows of chastity and poverty, have to busy themselves with other cares like teaching, nursing, tilling the soil perhaps, house-keeping, writing and many such activities. They cannot and do not spend all their day and every day in prayer and meditation. Nor does Christ demand this of them.

Much less, therefore, does He demand this of the ninety-nine percent of His followers who have to take on themselves financial and family cares. It is by fulfilling these worldly duties in a Christian way that they are dedicating themselves to His service. This is their total commitment to Christ. The married man or woman who is loyal to his or her life-partner and to the family, if there is one, and who provides diligently and honestly for his own and the family's spiritual and temporal welfare, and who always does this with the intention of pleasing God, is following Christ and is moving steadily day by day towards heaven.

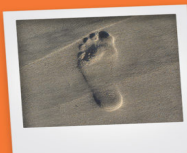

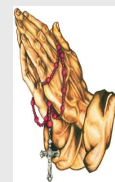

Lecturas dominicales, Año C:

La Primera Lectura está tomada del Libro de la Sabiduría 9:13-18a. En el extracto de hoy, el autor enfatiza la incapacidad del hombre para comprender los planes y decretos divinos. Debido a que somos seres finitos y limitados, nuestro conocimiento es finito y limitado. Hay muchos problemas limitados y finitos a nuestro alrededor, que no podemos resolver. ¿Cómo podríamos esperar resolver los infinitos?

La Segunda Lectura es de San Pablo a Filemón 9b-10, 12-17. Esta carta es la más corta de las cartas de San Pablo y al mismo tiempo la más personal y conmovedora. Durante su primer encarcelamiento en Roma (61-63), un esclavo llamado Onésimo, que se había escapado de su amo cristiano Filemón, natural de Colosas, se acercó a Pablo en Roma y se convirtió al cristianismo. Pablo lo envió de regreso a su amo con esta carta, en la que Pablo apela conmovedoramente a Filemón para que trate con amabilidad al fugitivo.

El Evangelio es de San Lucas 14, 25-33 y nos enseña que la condición esencial para el verdadero discipulado, exigido por Cristo, era y sigue siendo la entrega total, el compromiso total de uno mismo con Él. No puede haber tal persona como un medio cristiano. "El que no está conmigo, está contra mí", dijo en otra ocasión. No podemos estar a favor de Cristo el domingo y contra Él el resto de la semana. Para ser sus verdaderos discípulos, sus verdaderos seguidores, debemos vivir nuestra vida cristiana todos los días y todos los días.

Seguir a Cristo significa hacer nuestro camino al cielo. Es un viaje de vida. Tenemos un tiempo limitado para completar este viaje. Por lo tanto, debemos recorrer una cierta distancia cada día. Esto no significa que debamos pasar todos los días en oración y meditación. Hay otras tareas por hacer, pero debemos cristianizar estas otras tareas. Incluso los miembros de órdenes religiosas que "dejan el mundo", es decir, que se liberan de las preocupaciones familiares y económicas de este mundo por sus votos de castidad y pobreza, tienen que ocuparse de otras preocupaciones como enseñar, cuidar, cultivar tal vez la tierra, el cuidado de la casa, la escritura y muchas actividades por el estilo. No pueden y no pasan todo el día y todos los días en oración y meditación. Cristo tampoco exige esto de ellos.

Mucho menos, por tanto, exige esto del noventa y nueve por ciento de sus seguidores que tienen que asumir los cuidados económicos y familiares. Es cumpliendo estos deberes mundanos de una manera cristiana que se están dedicando a su servicio. Este es su compromiso total con Cristo. El hombre o mujer casado que sea leal a su compañero de vida y a la familia, si la hubiere, y que provea diligente y honestamente por su propio bienestar espiritual y temporal y el de la familia, y que lo haga siempre con la intención de agradar a Dios, es seguir a Cristo y avanzar día a día con paso firme hacia el cielo. —Extraído del Ciclo C de Lecturas Dominicales, p.
