SV/NL Administrator's Report:

1. Communications

- a. The Augustine Institute electronic service for Christian formation <u>FORMED.ORG</u> is active. Parish Code for registration is HJ8C8W. Participants enter name, email address and then set a personal password. Bulletin announcements and banners are forthcoming with instruction to register.
- b. An electronic newsletter for each parish has been initiated since Easter. It will be sent out biweekly. Fr Carmelo asked Council to consider combining parishes on the email blast. Presently, SV and NL have separate headers and contact footer information on the email blast but have the same content. Duplication of effort for the sake of individual parish identity is not efficient.
- c. Eric Schmidt, SV, raised a website capacity issue. LPI hosts the websites for SV and NL. The sites were built with the intention that ministry leaders would manage their areas. LPI is user friendly but lacks capacity to link to platforms like FORMED.ORG or other systems that might be needed in the future. A new host might be necessary. Additional cost would need to be determined. E. Schmidt will inquire with LPI about their efforts to expand hosting capability. A follow up report to joint Council will be given in May.

OLD BUSINESS

- 1. Recording Secretary was tasked with summary re-write of compiled results from the NL Parish Survey intended for bulletin insert. Survey summary presented to Council is acceptable.
- 2. Call for Pastoral Council member nominations. Two positions are scheduled for rotation.
- 3. Parish Volunteer Ad Hoc Committee review of volunteer activity. Council liaisons are asked to discuss volunteer needs with the Ministry Committee/Commission leads.
- 4. The Fund-Raising Committee concerned with the Parish Raffle recommended to Finance Council on Mar
- 15, 2018, a special night for raffle drawing as a separate event. Resolution: Separate raffle at Fall dinner (tentative Saturday Oct 6, 2018) without auction of baskets. Spring dinner will include auction f baskets. New menu choices are under consideration. Broader participation is a goal.
- 5. The Christian Ladies Guild selection of a qualifying communicant to participate in the May Crowning event is complete.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Discussion of possible alternatives for offsite annual picnic for out years such as a "Block Party" scenario to draw more participation. Need to plan costs for area notices, permits, insurance, and other associated necessities. To be continued.
- 2. Discussion of other fund-raising possibilities such as "Bingo Night" at an offsite bingo parlor, e.g., St Francis Lions Club.
- 3. Discussion of possibility to merchandise apparel as a fund raiser. Pastoral Council is asked to determine interest.

COMMISSION/COMMITTEE REPORTS

Finance: Shirley Robinson

Parish Finance Council meeting was held Mar 15, 2018. Next meeting scheduled for Apr 19, 2018. A priority list of projects was discussed with South Campus demolition leading. Water intrusion through aged roofing and weathered tuck pointing on the school has caused serious damage. Emergency repair is needed. By agreement with City of Cudahy, phase 1 of 3 phases for demolition of South Campus begins in Aug 2018. Financing for the 3-phase project is tenuous. Fr Carmelo will meet with the Archdiocese to explore finance mechanisms.

Youth Ministry

Programs for St John Bosco Youth Ministry, Life Teen for middle school, program for high school under development for 2019.

Committee plans to create a Christian Formation Calendar for events, presentations, and Formation series offered to South Shore Parishes.

Human Concerns Committee meeting was held Apr 5, 2018. Next meeting is scheduled for May 10, 2018. A **South Shore Collaborative Human Concerns** meeting is postponed from Apr 18 due to weather and rescheduled for May 16, 2018, at Sacred Heart of Jesus.

An **Earth Day Project** is scheduled for Apr 22, 2018. All South Shore Parishes are invited through posters and bulletin announcements. Clean Up of grounds and woods will occur at St. Francis Seminary/Cousins Center. A Liability Release waiver will be required for participants.

Run/Walk with the Capuchin Friars for Milwaukee's Hungry at Polish Fest is being promoted for Friday, Jun 15, 2018. All South Shore Parishes are invited through posters and bulletin announcements. Team name will be "South Shore Catholic Holy Soles."

Project Concern is celebrating 50 years of operation with a display at Cudahy Library until the end of May and an Open House on Apr 7, 2018.

A **Respect Life Committee** meeting was held on Apr 3, 2018, at SV. Next meeting is scheduled for May 8, 2018.

Mother's Day Rose Sale is planned for May 12 and 13 after Mass. Proceeds will be given to WI Right-to-Life. Volunteers have been asked to sell 150 roses.

The Respect Life Cluster of SE Wisconsin will sponsor a presentation on "*Strong Fathers- Strong Family*" on Tuesday Apr 17, 2018, to be held at St John Evangelist location. Invitation to all South shore Parishes is by posters and bulletin announcement.

The Committee is planning for a presentation regarding "Sidewalk Counseling and Pro-Life Conversations with Pro-Abortion and Pro-Choice Advocates." The program is intended for all six South Shore Parishes, specifically for those interested in ending abortion and saving lives. A speaker, Therese Aloia (Program Director at Pro-life WI), has accepted an invitation to talk. Tentative dates are Saturdays in 2018 September 8 or 15 or 22. Suggested location is Nativity of the Lord school hall.

The MAY – JUNE **topic for brochure rack information** is: THE CATHOLIC FAMILY. It will focus on sacramental ties in the Family like Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation. Emphasis will be on Sacraments and raising children as Catholics. It is oriented with Mother's Day and Father's Day.
