**Review and approve April, 2023 meeting minutes.** Motion to approve minutes by Debbie Shawgo, Rachel Green seconds the motion, all members in favor, none oppose.

Brief council member presentation and congratulations to Fr. Joe on his 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood

#### **Eucharistic Miracle Parish Council Volunteer Thank You!**

Had roughly 250 to 275 people attending. Information on obtaining more information about the Eucharistic Miracles was provided to those asking.

### Fr. Joe Updates

- Heard positive things from Eucharistic miracle display
  - Cathedral is going to have the full 158 panel display all of July. Would like to put notice in the bulletin of the dates (Pat will contact Cathedral to ascertain the display dates)
  - o 3 bids on drainage in parking lot
    - Martin Engineering Co. suggested Keppler, cheapest bid.
      - Have to wait for Village approval, papers to come in, and then present the proposed capital expenditure to the Diocese for approval.
    - Had one roofing company come in to look at hail damage to the church roof. Bruce Thompson will contact diocese about findings.
  - Communion seems to be going very well.
    - Gavin and Liz commented about some congestion with only 2 wine cups. Fr.
      Joe notes it might be difficult to get 4 consumers of the remaining wine especially for the 4:30pm mass.
    - Council suggest moving to 3 consumers, Father will explore option to have 3 and check the Eucharistic Minister schedule.
    - Jackie Viste was hired as new Preschool teacher.
    - Eucharistic Congress. Parish Council members should let Fr. Joe know if they or their spouse, or significant other are planning on attending
    - Corpus Christi is June 11. Same day as the Golf outing. Discussion about having adoration after Mass or a procession? Consider many in choir will be

at golf outing but could still sing and pray during a procession. Board provided comments to Fr. Joe for his consideration.
