- Review and approve March 2025 meeting minutes
 - A motion was made to approve minutes- Liz Reef
 - Seconded by Rob Flesher.
 - o All council members were in agreement to approve.

Fr Joe Updates:

- Campaign updates
 - 70% of pledges have been received; Some are using the campaign envelopes each month too.
 - Permission granted for emergency approval for lighting project inside the church. Items have been ordered through B&B. This has been moved up from the Fall project list due to need.
 - The sound system updates will stay on track for the Fall timeframe.
 - Bathroom project start at the end of June along with flooring.
 - New carpet for Kollross and O'Hara Hall- whole area with same carpeting.
 - Kitchen
 - Flooring with grip for nonslip feature.
 - 1-2 stoves (our old stoves not bad but need a coupler that is not made anymore).
 - Location of dishwasher to be reversed for better flow.
 - New grease trap to be installed (the sink will be removed to install this).
 - The bathroom in the kitchen will be replaced to make room for the installation of a freezer and ice machine.
 - Storage shed outside one of the last projects to be completed.
 - Additional projects:
 - Window replacement down the hall (poor seals and cloudy looking in appearance).
 - Landscaping around the office.
 - Maintenance on movable partitions in Kollross Hall.
 - Rachel suggests before/after pictures for projects to show updates.
- Pictorial directory planning project- This may start as early as July 2025-September;
 Stewardship committee working on this project.
- YNOT tragedy update
 - St Joseph's was a drop off location for meal donations for the affected families.
 - A monetary collection at all masses was taken up for the affected families.

- Check sent to 4 families whose children perished in the tragedy.
- Donation sent to Glenwood High School Student Council.
- Plans to send a donation to the 6 families with children suffering critical injuries.
- May send a portion to a family affected from our parish and considering other individuals for continued financial needs.
- A parishioner suggested having an additional loose collection in a couple weeks for these families again- the parish council members agreed that this would be nice.
- Concern sent via anonymous letter to Fr Joe regarding ability to hear/pray/concentrate during mass when children are upset and vocal.
 - Fr will place a message in the bulletin to remind parishioners about the children's cry room access.
 - Pastoral council agrees that we love the sounds of little ones at Mass but a reminder that the cry room is available would be appropriate.
