
Parent Commitment

Information on Saints, Sponsors, & the Restored Order Mass Spring 2023

Choosing Your Confirmation Name

- One of the traditional practices in the Church at the time of Confirmation is choosing a name that will remind you of this sacrament.
- Your prayerful reflection will help you decide on that name.
- You have a choice to **keep your baptismal name**, signifying that you are confirming the faith that was given to you at your Baptism. *Please note that while this is an option, it is Bishop Paprocki's preference for you to select a saint name instead of keeping your baptismal name.
- You may also **choose to add a name**, to signify your new and deeper awareness of what it means to be a disciple of Jesus.
- If the choice is made to add a new name; it is to be a Christian name.
- It should reflect a saint whom you can admire and imitate.

The second enrichment will cover a discussion of saints, but the Saint Pennant will be completed at home and is **due on May 1**st.
