Information on Saints, Sponsors, & the Restored Order Mass

#### **Choosing Your Confirmation Name**

- One of the traditional practices in the Church at the time of Confirmation is choosing a name that will **remind you of this sacrament.**
- Your prayerful reflection will help you decide on that name.
- You have a choice to **keep your baptismal name**, signifying that you are confirming the faith that was given to you at your Baptism. \*Please note that while this is an option, it is Bishop Paprocki's preference for you to select a saint name instead of keeping your baptismal name.
- You may also choose to add a name, to signify your new and deeper awareness of what it
  means to be a disciple of Jesus.
- If the choice is made to add a new name; it is to be a Christian name.
- It should reflect a saint whom you can admire and imitate.
