- The bank balance as of 6/30/2022 was \$11,286.64; Checkbook balance as of 6/30/2022 of \$10,786.64, the difference being one outstanding check to St. Patrick School of \$500.

Old Business:

• Raffle:

- As previously reported, the State of Illinois now requires a "license" to hold "x" number of raffles.
- The cost is \$400 for a two-year license, covering four events per year for a total of eight events.
- A portion of the proceeds (10 or 20 %?) is also required to be submitted to the State of Illinois.
- We will revisit the raffle topic once we have activities scheduled again.
