# St. Joseph the Worker - TEAM Meeting Minutes March 19, 2023

## **Opening Prayer:**

• TEAM President Peggy Billhartz called the meeting to order at 9:18 am with the opening prayer.

## **Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes:**

- Minutes from the Meeting of February 19, 2023:
  - o The Minutes from our February 19, 2023, meeting was presented.
    - A <u>motion was made</u> by Mary Alice Keith; seconded by Geoffrey Davis; to approve the minutes as presented. Motion approved.

# **Approval of Treasurer's Report:**

- For the month of March 2023:
  - o The bank balance as of 2/28/2023 was \$15,648.53; Checkbook balance was also \$15.648.53.
    - Please note that these numbers are prior to the distribution of the recent Pancake & Sausage
      Breakfast proceeds to our two food pantries of Chatham and Holy Family in Springfield.
      - A <u>motion was made</u> by Geoffrey Davis; seconded by Mel Kuntemeier; to approve the Treasurer's Reports as presented. Motion approved.

## **Old Business:**

## • TEAM Polo Shirts:

- Geoff Davis had previously reported at our September 2021 meeting that polo shirts (cotton / polyester) from Greco will run \$18.95 for small through extra-large. Larger sizes will run a bit more (+ \$2). Greco's can get the green like we have now but are having a terrible time getting supplies.
- They look nice. Please let Geoff know if you are interested in purchasing one.

## Pancake & Sausage Breakfast—was held on January 15, 2023:

- Mel Kuntemeier presented the Final Financial Report from our recent Breakfast. This included a one-page summary along with a two-page summary analysis of results going back to 1989.
- Thanks to a number of donations, we had our best year ever, raising \$3,806.23 after expenditures.
- o Donations included, but are not limited to the following:
  - \* Rodger Anderson Donation of blueberries, chocolate chips and some other supplies.
  - ❖ Advertising & some supplies donated by Mel Kuntemeier.
  - ❖ Tom Walters donated his 50/50 winnings back to the breakfast. Thanks Tom!
  - ❖ A number of folks made an additional contribution at the ticket purchase table.
  - Bake Sale Items.
- TEAM had previously approved the splitting of the net proceeds to go to Ball Chatham Food Pantry and Holy Family Food Pantry in Springfield.
- After a brief discussion it was the consensus of the group to round the total donation up to \$3,810 so that the distribution would be \$1,905 to each.
  - A motion was made by Rodger Anderson; seconded by Geoffrey Davis; to approve the distribution of the total net profit (rounded up) from our breakfast of \$3,810, to be split between

the two food pantries (\$1,905 as a check to Ball Chatham Food Pantry; and \$1,905 in gift cards to Holy Family). Motion approved.

- o Mel will distribute to the respective food pantries along with a cover letter.
- Peggy suggested getting a picture of the distribution.

- Peggy reported that we need to get our events scheduled with Secretary Sue on the Church Calendar The sooner the better!
- Rodger stated that there is now another form to be completed as part of the approval process through the Church Finance Council.

- Sister Judy reported that there is a need for blackout shades in Kohlross Hall for when movies are being shown there.
- o The shades have already been ordered. The cost is unknown at this time.

### Other:

#### Kitchen & Other Needs:

- Mary Jo Wehmhoff mentioned some of the needs noted when she helped with the recent Owls Potluck.
- ❖ Discussion followed regarding the ongoing lack of storage issues to safeguard our various equipment and other items.
- For example, Mel Kuntemeier stores the big Hamilton Beach coffee pots and the Pancake & Syrup Bottles at his house after both were not properly cared for at Church and had to be replaced.
  - As a side note, Mel and Carol purchased the four new coffee pots; TEAM purchased the syrup bottles.
- ❖ Damage to the new roasters purchased by TEAM has happened and is a concern.
- Peggy and Carol Gustafson both store WATCH RETREAT items at their houses to make sure have for the next retreat.
- Other items such as flooring and roofing issues come under the Building Committee, and it was suggested she take it up with them.
- \* Rodger Anderson reported that the Building & Maintenance Committee is aware of a number of the issues.... Comes down to funding and priorities.

## o Chicken Dinner (Drive-Thru): Saturday Evening May 6th from 4 to 7 pm.:
