

## Subject Pronouns in Spanish

The subject pronouns in Spanish are listed below:

SINGULAR		PLURAL	
<b>yo</b>	I	<b>nosotros</b> <b>nosotras</b>	we (masculine or mixed group) we (feminine)
<b>tú</b>	you (familiar)	<i>vosotros</i> <i>vosotras</i>	<i>you (familiar, masc. or mixed)</i> <i>you (familiar, feminine)</i>
<b>usted</b>	you (formal)	<b>ustedes</b>	you (familiar and formal)
<b>él</b>	he, it	<b>ellos</b>	they (masculine or mixed)
<b>ella</b>	she, it	<b>ellas</b>	they (feminine)

Note: They only use the *vosotros* (as) form in the country of Spain. In this class, we will always use the *ustedes* form when talking about you in the plural. *Ustedes* is used as both the familiar and the formal in Latin America which is the way we will use it as well.
