



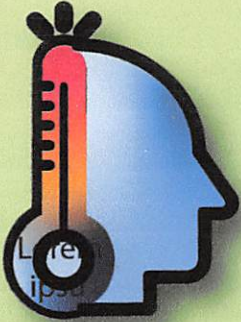

## FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL



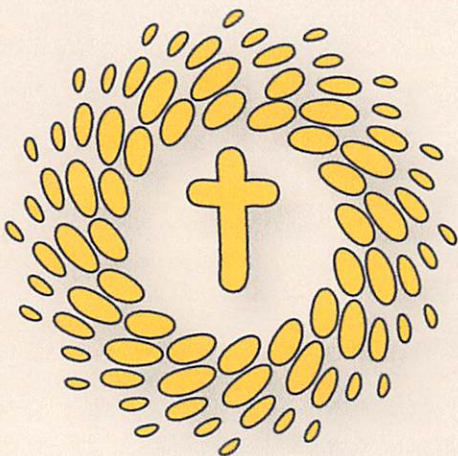
If you have a fever or symptoms of COVID-19 you will not be permitted to enter the building. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or more Fahrenheit or having a persistent cough should remain home. Those with compromised immunity, underlying health issues and are age 65+ are encouraged to stay home as well.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

All present at the liturgy, ages 5 and up, and those receiving communion, must wear cloth face coverings. At church, social distancing will be practiced, with a minimum of six feet between people not living in the same household. Please refrain from holding hands during the Lord's Prayer or shaking hands during the Sign of Peace. The faithful are strongly encouraged to receive holy Communion by hand. Those who wish to receive on the tongue are asked to receive Communion after those who have received it by hand.

Arrive at least 30 minutes before Mass begins and you will be shown by ushers where to safely take your seat. Please remember that due to the gathering limits set by the Governor of Virginia no social gatherings may occur before or after Mass.

## *Welcome to Saint Olaf Catholic Church*

By entering St. Olaf Catholic Church, all employees, visitors, and vendors/contractors acknowledge the following:

- Your temperature is under 100.4 degrees.
- You do NOT have a fever or other symptoms of COVID-19, without an alternative diagnosis. Other symptoms include chills, sore throat, cough, shortness of breath, muscle pain, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.
- You have NOT had a positive diagnostic test for the virus that causes COVID-19 in the prior 10 days.
- You have NO known exposure to a COVID-19 case in the prior 14 days; exposure being less than six (6) feet for greater than a cumulative 15 minutes over a 24 hour period, without wearing the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as defined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

If any individual cannot acknowledge the statements above, they will not be permitted to enter the building. A cloth face covering is required in accordance with the Amended Executive Order #63.
