Sacraments of our Faith

BAPTISM OF INFANTS—Contact Fr. Woody

Baptisms of children under seven years-old are scheduled as needed. Please visit our website or contact Fr. Woody in the office for details and requirements.

THE SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING—Call the Parish Office

A person does not need to wait until the point of death to receive this sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. The Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after the anointing but becomes ill once again, or if, during the same illness, the person's condition becomes more serious. For those who are about to depart from this life, the Church offers the person Penance, Anointing of the Sick and the Eucharist as Viaticum (food for the journey) given at the end of life.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE—Contact the Parish Office

If you are a registered parishioner of Our Lady of Lourdes and plan to marry in our parish, please contact Fr. Woody at least six months prior to the tentative wedding date. All dates are tentative until the marriage preparation process is complete and a determination is made about the freedom of the parties to marry.

CCW Summer Bridge


