Mission of Christ the King Student Leadership

As CTK Student Leaders, we are community of missionary disciples who are committed to bringing LSU students to Christ, forming them as intentional disciples, and equipping them for a lifetime of mission through cultivation of their God-given gifts and charisms.

CTK Student Leadership Overview & Descriptions

CTK Student Leadership is designed to help us carry out the mission at CTK. Because there are various teams and ministries, each student has a place to use their unique gifts to effectively build up the Body of Christ on campus at LSU. Below are the descriptions of the different teams and leadership roles. ***Please note on the next page the commitments that each role requires. Also remember that you do not have to serve on a leadership team in order to simply attend or participate in the events/activities that said team plans.***

Small Group Leaders-

Lead weekly Bible studies in order to facilitate encounters with Jesus and build authentic relationships, with the hope and intention of forming disciples of Christ. *You must have been in a Bible study before in order to be a small group leader.*

Prayer Team-

Intercedes for the ministry and needs of Christ the King Church and the Campus of LSU, and facilitates prayer opportunities for the community. This team is made up of 2 Core Leaders, and various team members that will assist the Core Leaders in prayer and planning.

Service Team-

Actively works as the hands and feet of God by organizing and executing various service opportunities for the parish, campus, and local community to participate in. The team is made up of 2 Core Leaders, and various team members that will assist the Core Leaders in putting together service opportunities.

Hospitality Team-

Acts as the "face" of Christ the King by welcoming and greeting people at Sunday Mass and other events. This team is ESSENTIAL in cultivating a fruitful environment for a healthy and welcoming community. This team is made up of 2 Core Leaders, and various team members that will assist the Core Leaders in organizing hospitality greeters at events.

Outreach Team-

Building relationships and evangelizing others.

No need to apply – you're already on it, the Holy Spirit tagged you at Baptism.

***Tiger Awakening Leaders-**

Plan and implement the Tiger Awakening Retreat. *Please note these leaders are chosen separately from the rest of leadership, and must have attended Tiger Awakening before.*

***Music Ministry-**

Students with musical talent who help with praise and worship, liturgical music, etc.... *Please note that these leaders are chosen separately from the rest of leadership, and should contact Mark Labelle if interested.*

Expectations of Leaders:

- * **All Leaders** must commit to having a growing relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ, and living a Sacramental Life within the Church. This *includes but is not limited to attending Mass frequently (at least on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation), Confession once a month or when in a state of mortal sin, and daily personal prayer.*
- * **All Leaders** are expected to be a missionary witness, and help build and cultivate a nurturing community at CTK. (An essential part of this is talking to new people – it’s fun, you’ll like it).
- * **All Leaders** are called to serve from a place of gratitude and generosity.
