Centennial Campaign

- 1) St. Aloysius Church interior Remodel to include:
  - a. Interior Painting (Includes scaffolding rental)
  - b. Renovation of Confessional
  - c. ADA lift for Alter  
New ADA Ramp/ Stairs on
  - e. New electrical
  - f. New flooring
  - g. New Entry Doors
  - h. Remodel restrooms
  - i. Baptismal Fount
  - j. Sound System
- 2) St Joseph Parish Hall
  - a. Remove ceiling tile and registers.
  - b. Lighting
  - c. Remove all wall finishes. Go back with a durable wainscot, painted drywall above.
  - d. Construct a PSR Office
  - e. New folding partitions and with new locations – 6 class rooms
  - f. Drywall the bottom of trusses above the ceiling.
  - g. Replace two HVAC units (approaching 30 years old)
  - h. Rework electrical wiring. 400 amp service.
  - i. Install new floor covering.
  - j. Re-use cabinets in kitchen
  - k. Roll-up doors on east porch as an alternate to create ability to close off porch for use in inclement weather.

- 3) Replace St. Aloysius Parish Hall Roof: Remove and install new (30 year shingle). Replace any plywood and flashing as required.
- 4) St. Joseph Cemetery
  - a. Concrete road (create horse-shoe shape driveway)
- 5) St Aloysius Cemetery
  - a. Oil and Chip existing road
- 6) St Joseph Rectory Renovation –
  - a. Remove and replace back deck and steps with new concrete steps and concrete sidewalk/patio
  - b. Replace HVAC Unit on third floor

- c. Replace ceiling tile and grid on main floor and second floor (update lighting and registers).
  - d. Remodel second floor restroom
  - e. Paint and repair plaster walls and ceilings.
  - f. Repaint trim and doors
- 7) Immaculate Conception Parish Hall
  - a. Resurface existing parking lot
  - b. Lighting for parking lot
- 8) St. Joseph – Interior Remodel Funding
  - a. Future project for the painting of interior of St. Joseph Church. Existing painting is 20 years old. Possibly 5-10 years down the road.
- 9) Vocation Committee / Evangelism
  - a. Adult Education program
  - b. Funding for future seminary students
