In the Code of Canon Law promulgated in 1983, permission was given to receive communion more than once per day. Stewardship (Becky)

- Regarding the parish Stewardship campaign, of 941 families, 304 picked up their envelopes, 637 were mailed and 170 were returned. Many parishioners added talents and outside organizations that they support on their returned forms. These have been compiled into two lists and given to Christy for distribution to the rest of PC.
- Stewardship hosted our first ever Souper Bowl on February 11/12. It was a huge success! We served approximately 140 people between all masses and ran out of soup!
- Upcoming Meet & Eats:

 - April 23 Stewardship (=New Parishioner brunch) There are 11 new families invited, along with 2 families who have been re-invited because they could not attend the previous celebration.
 - May 20/21 Knights of Columbus Law Enforcement appreciation

- The next Fish Fry will be February 24. We will be introducing potato pancakes! We may need to increase prices. QoA Fish Fries are featured in a Journal Sentinel list of upcoming community fish fries.

Finance Council (Tom / Chris) See attached month end numbers for January, 2023

- Our overall financial situation is good. The budget is tight, owing to expenses with the security system, water softener, bathroom fixtures and new ovens. We are finalizing projects and have some payables left.
- We are planning for the expenditures and priorities for the funds from the Love One Another campaign. We will move ahead with projects as we are able.
- The new security system is almost finished, training on the system for key individuals will occur soon.
- There is a Waukesha County Church Grant. Father is meeting with the organization to see if we can apply for it.
- The assessment of our church property seems a bit high to the FC, which can affect the annual QoA
 property tax. We have 3 different parcels that could be divided or merged differently. We would like to
 solicit surveyors to see about the cost to survey.
- There was general discussion in PC about the unexpected greater cost of the new ovens. Unfortunately, with supply chain issues the original ovens we wanted were not available. It was important to secure new ovens with upcoming fish fries (and safety issues of not being able to cook food properly). According to the original request in October, 2022 FC meeting, the range of expected cost per oven was 3k-8k. The end cost was \$6500 each.

Strategic Plan / DMI Update (Christy) Father spoke about this earlier in the meeting. Nothing to add.

Christy will share lists of parishioner talents and outside organizations with PC members for reference.
