The G3 conference stressed the importance of using accurate data for making future plans in our ministries. We have data available from the DMI and a tool provided by the ArchD called MissionInsite that allows us to see detailed demographic data about who is in the community we are serving. The parish website can be a valuable tool that has goals and functions (ie: new member registration, accepts donations, sign ups for events). It should not be a repository of information, like an encyclopedia. There is no silver bullet for technology; different age groups are reached through different media (ie: bulletin, website, social media).
