Adult Bible Study program, "Fulfilled," will run from Oct. 17th to Dec. 5th. Looking to collaborate with St. Anthony's in 2019. Passion and Purpose with Matthew Kelly is Saturday, June 23rd, downtown Milwaukee. Christian Formation surveys were completed by students and parents and the results were discussed in our June meeting. 56 out of 130 families responded. Feedback was generally on the positive side. 89% were "Overall satisfied with Faith Formation," with no glaring issues in the bottom percentages. An overall trend was that parents were interested in us providing service ideas that they could take home and do as a family.
