BALANCE SHEET

- Cash increased \$44,230 for the month of August. The largest increase was the \$30,474 from LOA.
- Current Liabilities decreased \$6,140 for the month leaving a balance of \$16,384.

INCOME STATEMENT

- Revenue for the month of August was favorable to budget by \$56,641. \$30,474 came from LOA and \$20,671 from Church Revenue.
- Expenses came in unfavorable to the budget of \$58,245 by \$1,047. The largest unfavorable variance of \$4,857 came in Building & Grounds. This was primarily due to budget timing.
- Net Income is favorable to budget by \$55,593 with LOA and \$25,119 favorable without.

Registration – 53 families are registered. 38 out of the 47 families registered last year, returned. 9 families have left (5 were after First Communion), 7 families have returned (after an absence) and 8 families are new. Of the 119 families Liz Kuhn contacted (who are registered members of QOA, but don't have their children enrolled), 4 families responded. 1 family has left and 3 families enrolled. Chart with class size included in this report.

Elementary – Curriculum is *Families Forming Disciples* – theme is Sacraments. First Monday night dinner with instruction was October 16.

Middle School – Curriculum is *Echo the Story 12*. Theme is Sacred Scriptures.

High School – Curriculum is *Living Justice and Peace* – theme is Charity and Justice. There are plans to have several speakers: Tom Pipines and John Quaal to speak about prison ministry, Father Chuck to speak about his trip to Texas and the border, and the Capuchin Fathers regarding their food drive. High School is sponsoring a Thanksgiving Food Box Drive with the entire parish to benefit Capuchin Community Services.

Confirmation – Curriculum is *Anointed in the Spirit*. Kicked off the year with a parent/candidate evening.

Liz Kuhn and (now) Ellie Shaw (2 students) continue to work with many delayed sacraments or RCIA participants. 11 total in various stages of their instruction.

Adult Bible Study – Upcoming Wednesday offering is The Sermon on the Mount (October 25-November 15). Thursday night Bible Study is on pause, awaiting a new facilitator. Currently Debbie Bisswurm is facilitating Walking with Mary on Thursday nights.

Grace Majewski is investigating the possibility of bringing back Children's Liturgy of the Word during the mass.

The Small Group Facilitator Training at QOA on September 26 was well-received with 31 total participants, 18 from QOA. So far, 3 small groups have been formed. Next Envisioning meeting is November 13. The bus trip to Our Lady of Champions sold 55 out of the 56 seats available. Additional trips being considered: Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse, WI and the National Shrine of St. Maximilian Kolbe in Libertyville, IL.
