Commission/ Committee Reports	Lifelong Faith Formation (Christy) Youth - Christian Formation registration packet responses are coming back daily. - 2 youth will be participating the week of July 24 th at a Summer Outreach Camp doing community service. - Beth and Liz met with the organization Blessings in a Backpack. Helps K-5 kids who receive free or reduced price school lunches. They are looking at volunteer opportunities to incorporate with Christian Formation.	

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	 Donated / served food at the MacCanon Brown Homeless Sanctuary on June 23rd. Look at future options. Young Adult Archdiocese is encouraging Parishes to join small groups. QoA is offering a 3-week group session on Tues. nights starting Aug 1st entitled "Exploring the God Question." Property Sale – a lot of interest – no decisions have been made other than we are not contracting a broker at this time.
