Father Chuck / trustee report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Capital Campaign (Love One Another) was a success. We exceeded our goal (108%) with total pledges \$1,156,630. Father was particularly pleased with the percentage of parishioners who participated. Our goal was 22% participation and we finished with 26%. A special thank you to our co-chairs Dale and Patty Servais and Tom Pipines. Tomorrow (1/19) there will be a zoom with the Arch and all wave 2 parishes. This Friday (January 20), there will be a District wide zoom for Pastors and Parish Directors Saturday, May 20th is Father Chuck's 40th anniversary as a priest! Father will be attending a Mass in West Bend to celebrate his classmate's anniversary, but will preside for both Sunday Masses. That weekend is already set to recognize Law Enforcement for their service. Father thought we could have the celebration of his anniversary another weekend and perhaps combine that with the parish picnic or volunteer appreciation event. No decision was made on the date. This is an increase over 2021 (1162) and 2020 (885) Everyone seems to be ok with the new limited mask section. Last weekend there were between 12 and 20 people sitting in this space. P&W hosted the Meet and Eat in December. We used this opportunity to thank our ministers with an angel ornament and a very special thank you card made by Marcey Vescio. Thank you Marcey! The E-Team has been very busy changing the decorations from Ordinary time to Advent to Christmas and back to Ordinary time. Parishioners were able to take home our beautiful poinsettias. <p>Stewardship (Becky / Stephanie)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stewardship is hosting our first ever Souper Bowl on February 11/12. Parishioners are invited after all masses to enjoy a bowl of soup and bread. Upcoming Meet and Eats: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> March 25/26 - Christian Women April 23 - Stewardship (=New Parishioner brunch) May 20/21 - Knights of Columbus - Law Enforcement appreciation June - Undecided, considering food trucks, coordinating with Parish Picnic? The results of the Parish Stewardship campaign to present are: 161 families have pledged a total of \$302,000, an average of \$1879 per family. In 2021, 226 families pledged \$327,000, averaging \$1450 per family, Many people returned their forms pledging to serve in different ministries. All commission heads have received a listing of new volunteers to contact and welcome. The next Fish Fry will be February 24. Tom Schwai will bring the fish and supplies.
