LOA projects are beginning. The organ will be removed this summer and we are receiving new quotes for our AV system.</li> <li>• QoA received an anonymous gift of \$7500 towards the purchase of the new ovens.</li> <li>• The City of Pewaukee lowered our assessment by \$160k.</li> <li>• Building and Grounds are working on a few projects following an appropriate timeline.</li> </ul> <p><b>Strategic Plan / DMI Update</b> (Christy)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On May 22, at 6:30pm, there will be an exploratory meeting to gauge interest in small group leadership.
