# “Seal” Activity

- Step 1 = Take a paper with the outline of the envelope.
- Step 2 = Cut out the envelope along the outside edges.
- Step 3 = Fold the envelope along the four creases so the lines are on the inside.
- Step 4 = Where the envelope would be addressed, write your Confirmation name. Then write your full name in parentheses underneath.
- Step 5 = On the outside of each of the triangular flaps, write one of the following phrases so that a sentence is formed as you go around.

#4 Revelations 9 : 3 - 4


Having the seal of God offers protection.


