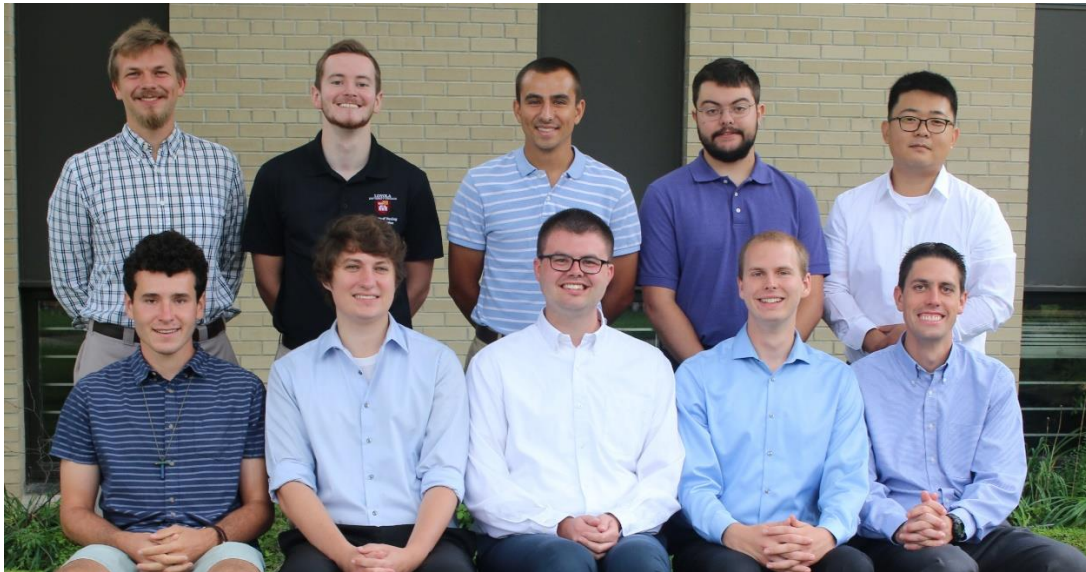

Noah Banasiewicz
Virginia Beach, Virginia
