

#### **COLLECT PRAYER**

GRANT, ALMIGHTY GOD,

through the yearly observances of holy Lent, that we may grow in understanding of the riches hidden in Christ and by worthy conduct pursue their effects. Through Jesus Christ, your Son.





As we enter the season of Lent, you will notice that our parish grows more active in spiritual and temporal ways. We are a dynamic and diverse parish, gathering many types of people who are drawn here for various reasons. We hope to serve all those who call St X their spiritual home. Please look over the enclosed variety of offerings to make Lent a holy and prayerful time.

I would like to suggest a Lenten activity that might be a bit unusual, but certainly beneficial for our parish community. I ask that each "parishioner" take time to update their individual or family parish membership.

In casual conversation with people, I am often asked the seemingly simple question, "So, Father, how many parishioners do you have at St Xavier?" And I stare at them blankly, not quite knowing how to answer. If I open up our computer database, I see we have 2964 "families" listed. And if I count that database by "individuals" the total comes to 4760 souls from 225 different zip codes. Of those, 2263 are listed as "active" members, but many have moved or do not live in town. 1238 individuals are listed as "visitors". Many people we see in church every week are not listed as either active or inactive. Still many others we see here a lot are not "in our database" at all! I could answer that 248 families use our Sunday envelopes. But that doesn't include the 113 families who give their donation automatically on line.

So, I guess I might answer that "We have about 1,100 parishioners, depending on how you count." The St Xavier "October count" for the last 5 years averages out to 1,168. Of the other 16 Ohio parishes within a 3 mile radius, the next largest weekly attendance is at St. Louis Church with an average of 850 per week. Our database shows 265 individuals from zip code 45202. But the next largest zip areas are 41075 (153) and 41017 (122). We are all over.

Finally, our office is asked by people all the time to verify that they are "members" of St Xavier, because they'd like to be married out of town, serve as a Confirmation sponsor, act as a Baptismal godparent, or enroll in a local Catholic high school. Unless that person is actually "registered" with us as an active member, we have no way to verify such active membership. We share the same concern as does the Cathedral parish down the street. Because of so many visitors, we find it difficult to know everyone and afford them the privileges and services of a parish.

So, I would like to suggest that Lent might be a good time to examine these four points of "active" membership. We hope that each member is one who:

- · faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days
- · is registered and on the parish census
- · participates in parish activities in each season
- · uses either envelopes or on-line means of tithing Please take some time this season to contact us to check your own membership status, to register as a member, or to update your membership details.

Thanks to the many, many of you who have done so thus far. We are extremely grateful for the hundreds who support St Xavier financially and with your sincere prayers that we might grow in the mission to serve the people of God led by many Jesuits and Ignatian companions under the patronage of St Francis Xavier. May your Lenten journey be a time of grace for you and all those who call St Xavier their spiritual home.

#### **LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE**

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person may eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon Catholics from age 14 onwards.




