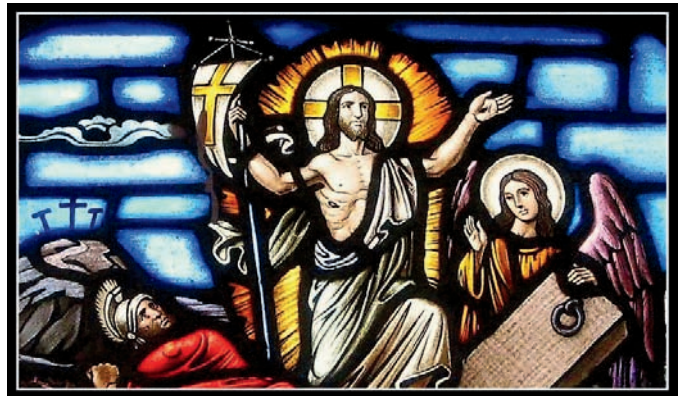

Jesus is Risen. HAPPY EASTER!

We welcome any visitors to Cincinnati this Easter weekend, and we welcome back those of you who only see us a few times each year. Many who attend Mass here are alumni of St Xavier High School, Xavier U, and other Jesuit schools. Many more have celebrated their baptisms and weddings here at St X. As well, many celebrate their burial Mass within these holy walls. The tradition continues for more than 200 years. To all who come by, consider St. Xavier your spiritual home.

You may notice that we are in the midst of our bicentennial year. This parish community celebrated its first Mass on Easter Sunday **April 11, 1819** in a different church building, at a different location than the present site. Before the Jesuits arrived, this parish had started with a few faithful Catholics who wanted to bring the faith and Sacraments to Southwestern Ohio. It is a time for us all to remember, rejoice, and reach out in mission to those most in need.

Please notice and reflect on two significant symbols of our parish mission. First, our normal blue "X logo" on the front of this bulletin and at the top of this page. The blue X logo reflects an "INWARD reflection" (the center of the X) as well as the 4 outward arrows that represent "OUTWARD action" flowing from the inner reflection. Our parish mission can be stated as "Inward reflection: Outward action." Thus, we are all "contemplatives in action." Our sacramental prayer inside this building must lead to active service outside. Notice that the blue X logo also parallels the design of our historic interior tile floors. Our worship space inspires us forward in the tradition of Francis Xavier. Blue has always been the color of the Cincinnati Jesuit schools here in Cincinnati.

So, when we decided upon a second image design for our bicentennial year: 2019, we chose to represent the three stately buildings that show the progress of our community over many years. The original wooden church was rolled 10 blocks to this site, where was started a parish, a school, a seminary, a university, and a cathedral. All have moved from here to other places in the Archdiocese. Our present church was built in 1859. The Catholic spirit survives and extends to all corners of the Archdiocese. Wherever you live, please consider coming to celebrate this growth in faith on Sunday May 19, 2019 at 10:30 am as Bishop Binzer joins the Jesuit Fathers and so many of our parishioners in our Bicentennial Mass of Thanksgiving.

- ❖ The St. Xavier Junior Temperance League was formed in April of 1902 to save boys from bad habits. You had to be under twenty-one years of age.
- ❖ In order to take a census, the pastors of St. Xavier church go door to door to visit those residing within the parish boundaries: March 1904
- ❖ October 1906 the St Xavier Branch High School opened at SW corner of Gilbert and Lincoln Ave.
