



Abba, Father

This weekend we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. In America we also celebrate Father's Day. The Trinity is one of the most challenging of the mysteries in the Catholic Faith – three persons in one triune God. It is the

central mystery of the Catholic faith and of Christian life, and God alone reveals it to us. Only faith allows us to believe it. I am certain each one of us could share their personal vision of each of the Three Persons in the Trinity. And each of us would be somewhat correct, for we use our own experiences to define the unknown. As a child, I envisioned God the Father as the Old Testament version: a rather stern, distant king. He controlled everything and we were not to disobey His commandments or the results could be damnation.

As I developed a more mature faith, I saw God, the Father, much in the same way as I did my own father. Firm, but fair; loving, but not necessarily demonstrative; a guide; a protector. Jesus referred to His Father as Abba, Dad. We come to understand God as this involved, caring Father through Jesus, His Son. Jesus invites us to ask anything of our heavenly Father and it will be granted.

That was certainly my personal experience of my own Dad. We did not have a lot of money as I was growing up. My mom was home with the five children, making ends meet. Dad was the provider – working two jobs to accomplish that. And yet, any opportunity offered to me to experience something extra and wonderful with friends or my school, my Dad found a way to make it happen. Ask and you shall receive had real meaning for me. I was one of the fortunate children with a kind and loving father. It colored everything about how I saw God. I could believe because I saw.

But many people did not have this experience. They must depend on *faith* to believe that God is a loving Father who wants only abundance for His children. They live in hope, not certainty, that their needs will be met. They accept in faith and with trust that God is always with them, listening to their prayers and answering them in ways that will benefit them.

We need faith to accept the feast we celebrate today. The Trinity is a mystery. We will not fully grasp it until we are no longer of the earth. Let's accept, in faith, the Three Persons who love, save and guide us throughout our lives. What a joyous time awaits when at last we see the face of God.

200 Years * 200 Facts

Researched by St X parishioner Jennifer Thumm

- On October 27, 1829, at the request of Bishop Fenwick, four Sisters of Charity from Emmitsburg, MD arrived at St. Xavier, having traveled 15 days by stage coach to Cincinnati.
- ❖ In April 1872, the Most Revered Archbishop Purcell administered the Sacrament of Confirmation to 200 in the new Cathedral. Here at St. Xavier's on the same day, he confirmed 350.
- ❖ In 1888 Fr. Eugene Brady S.J. became the 7th pastor of St Xavier Church.
- In 1915, in less than a year's time, the St X Nursery had under its care 20 babies ranging from 8 months to 5 years of age. They were tended to from early morning until evening while their mothers worked. Plus, 70 children were served a warm, nourishing meal at noon-time every day.


