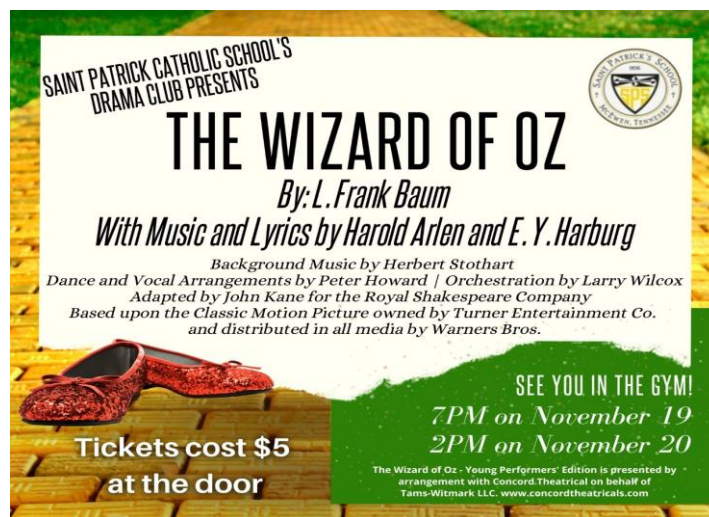
Thank you for your support of SVdP!
