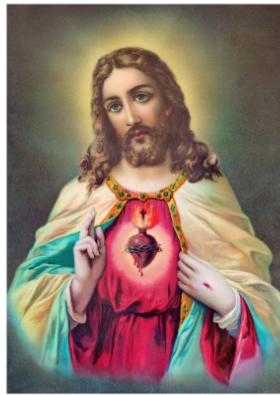

MASS INTENTIONS

THE CALENDAR FOR MASS INTENTIONS IS OPEN THROUGH THE END OF THE YEAR. MULTIPLE MASSES FOR THE SAME PERSON ARE GENERALLY LIMITED TO TWO PER YEAR ON SUNDAYS AND ONE PER MONTH FOR DAILY MASSES. EXCEPTIONS ARE MADE FOR RECENTLY DECEASED PARISHIONERS. LISTS OF MULTIPLE INTENTIONS WILL BE SAVED AND ADDED TO THE MASS CALENDAR MONTHLY ACCORDING TO AVAILABILITY TO ALLOW OTHERS THE OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A SINGLE MASS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR AND TO ADJUST FOR CANCELED MASSES. A REQUESTED DATE IS NOT GUARANTEED UNTIL IT IS ENTERED ON THE CALENDAR. WE MAY LIMIT MULTIPLE SUNDAY REQUESTS (WHICH INCLUDES THE VIGILS) FROM THE SAME FAMILY. THE USUAL STIPEND IS \$10 PER MASS BUT IS NOT REQUIRED.

Sacrament Information

- Infant Baptism: Baptism preparation classes take place in English and in Spanish as needed for parishioners who've been registered at least six months. Contact Father Abraham or Felix Leon (Spanish instruction) or call the parish office to register.
- Confession: Confessions are heard every day before Mass during Adoration, every Saturday from 4:00-4:45 PM, and on request.
- Sacrament of Matrimony: Contact the pastor at least 4 months prior to proposed wedding date to receive marriage preparation. Couples must fulfill all diocesan regulations.
- Anointing of the Sick: Anyone who is at risk of death or old age can receive this Sacrament; please inform the Pastor if any parishioners are unwell.
