

FAITH FORMATION

If you are parking to take children into religious ed classes or pick them up, please park in the north (lower) lot so that people who use the handicapped parking or can't take the stairs can park in the south lot and use the ramp into the church for Mass.

There are entrance arrows to the south lot directing traffic into a one-way pattern; do not pause to drop off older children in a way that blocks people from parking.

Please try to leave a few minutes earlier to allow time to drop off in the north lot when possible. There should not be a line in the street waiting to drop off/pick up in the south lot. There are stairs down into the social hall on both sides of the church entrance.





OCIA (formerly known as RCIA) is the ADULT FORMATION class for those wishing to join the Church, complete their Sacraments of Initiation by getting Confirmed, or reconnect after an absence from the Church. Sacrament Information

Infant Baptism: Baptism preparation classes take place in English and in Spanish as needed for parishioners who've been registered at least six months. Contact Father Abraham or Felix Leon (Spanish instruction) or call the parish office to register.

- •Confession: Confessions are heard every day before Mass during Adoration, every Saturday from 4:00-4:45 PM, and on request.
- Sacrament of Matrimony: Contact the pastor at least 4 months prior to proposed wedding date to receive marriage preparation. Couples must fulfill all diocesan regulations.
- Anointing of the Sick: Anyone who is at risk of death or old age can receive this Sacrament; please inform the Pastor if any parishioners are unwell.
