Rev. Michael J. Stumpf, is the son of Rose and Joseph Stumpf, and brother to Daniel and Curt. He was born and raised in a small country town outside of Butler, PA, called Herman, and was a member the Capuchin Parish, St. Mary of the Assumption.

His schooling Includes six years at St. Mary Catholic Grade School, and then Butler Junior, Intermediate and Senior High Schools. After two years of college at California University of PA, Fr.
