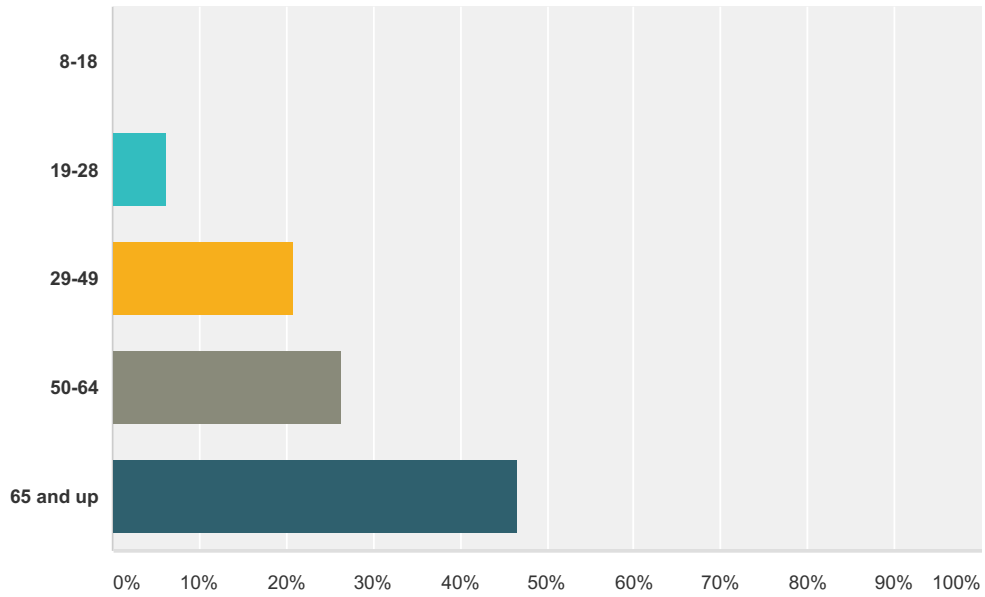

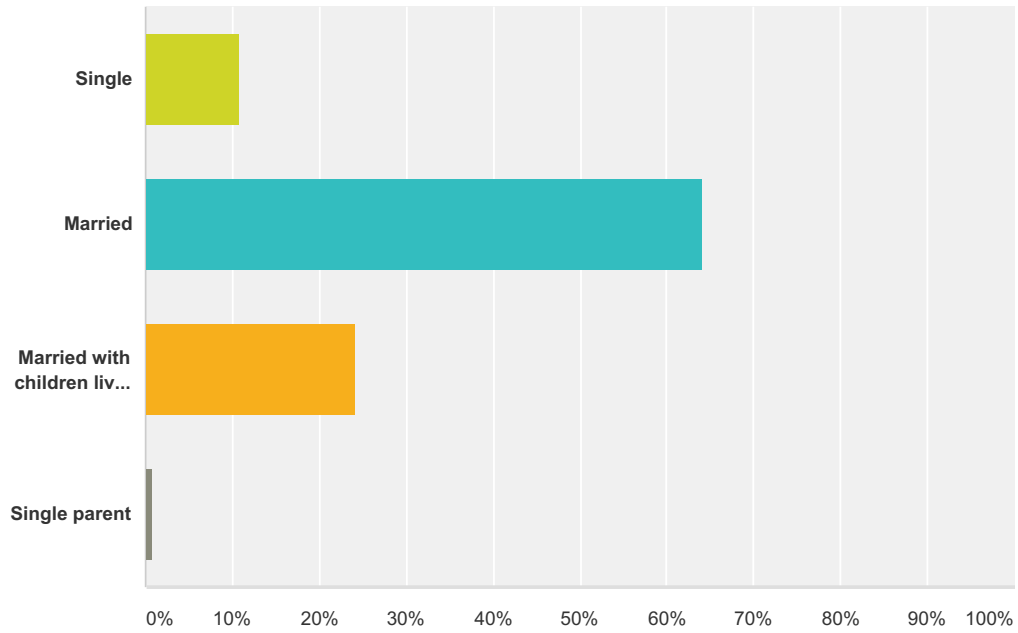

Q2 What is your current family status?

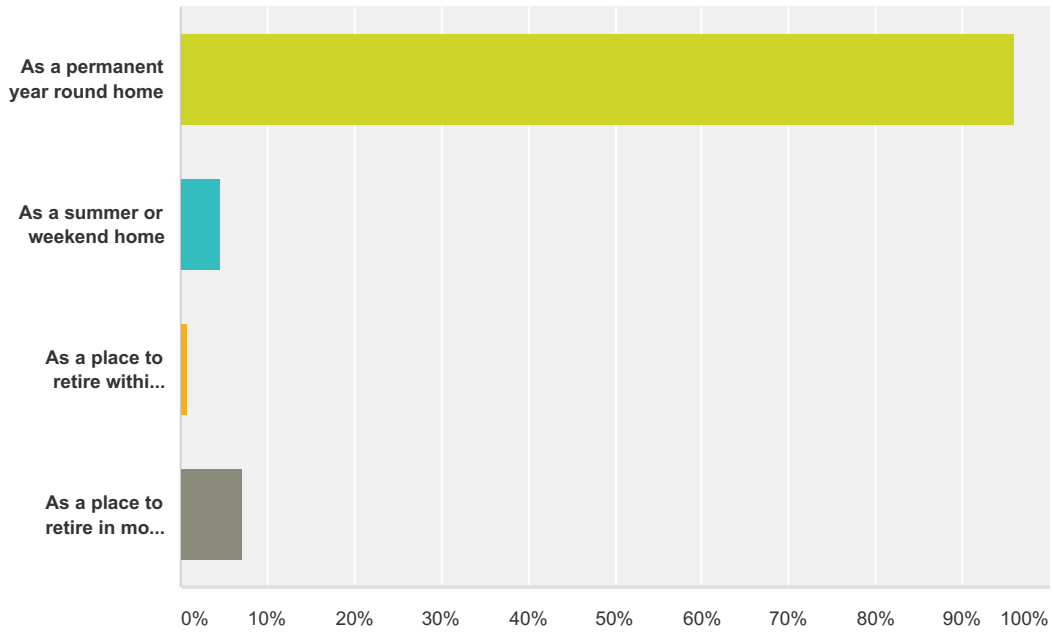

Q3 How do you view your home in this community? (You may check two answers.)

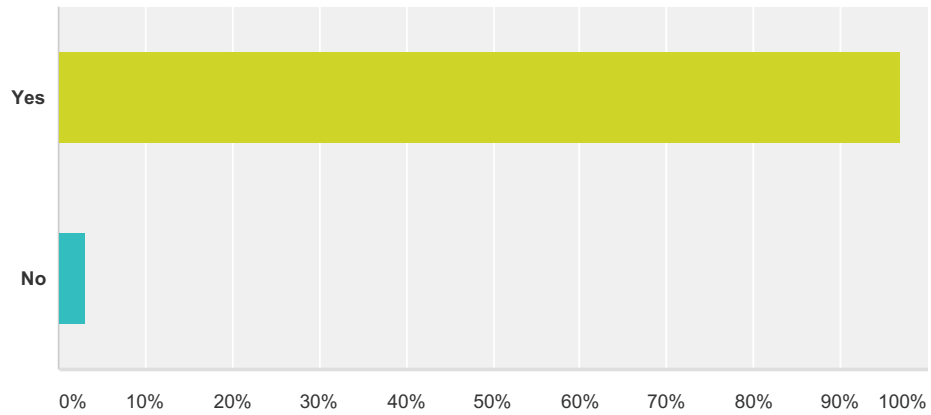

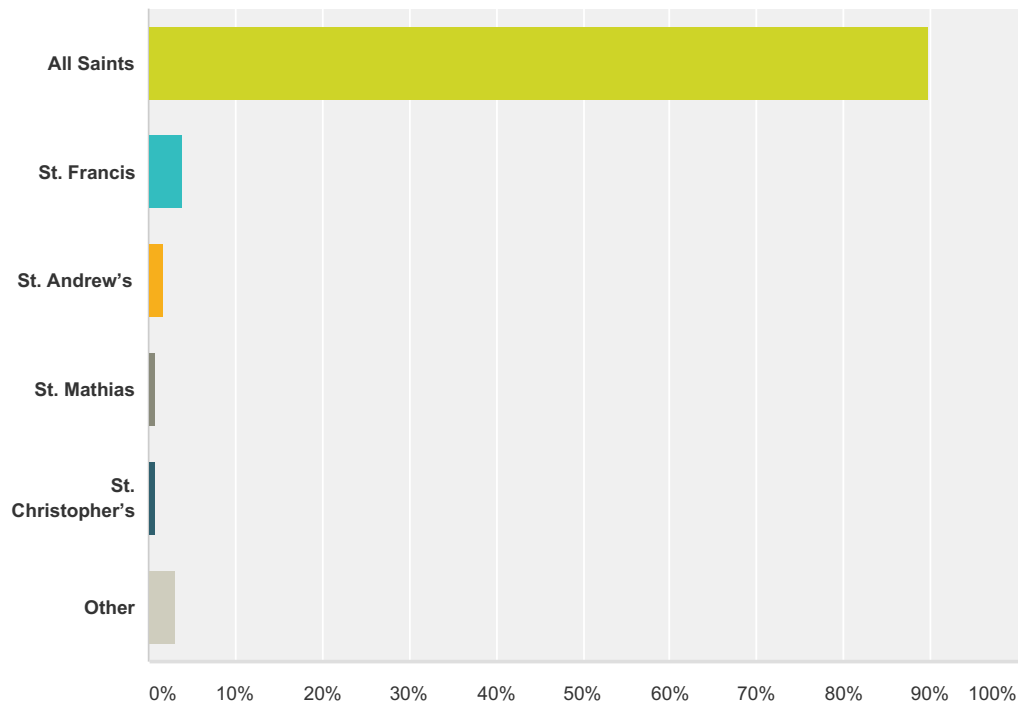

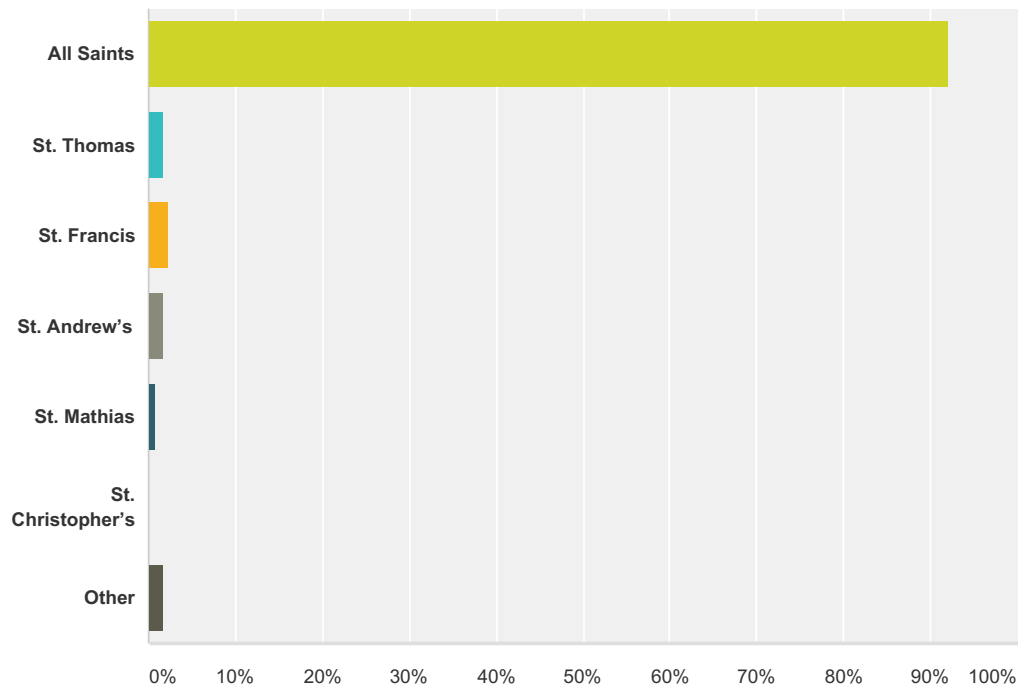

Q7 At which church do you regularly attend Mass?

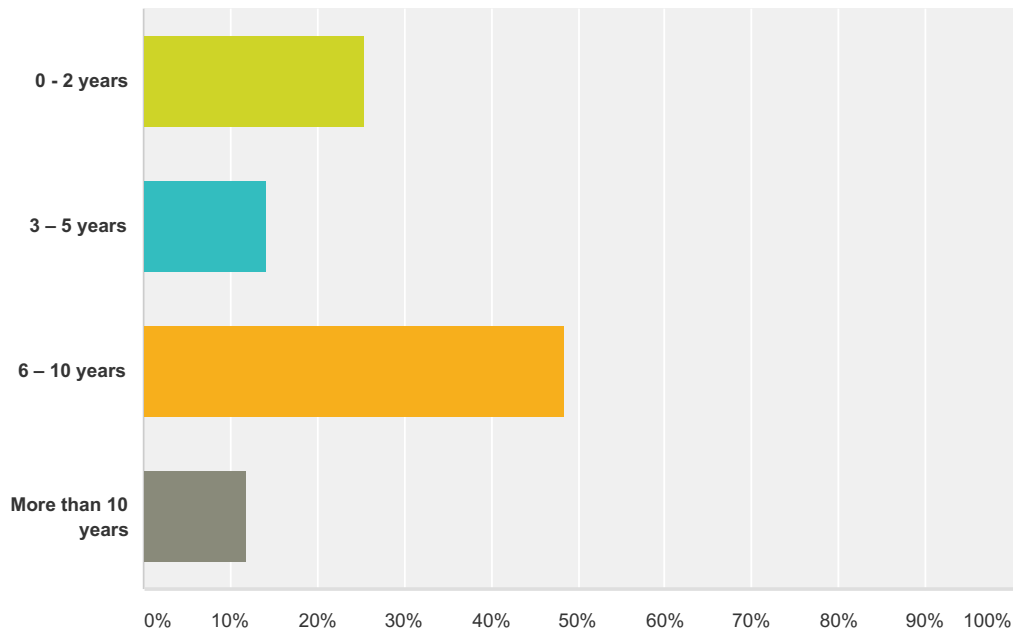

Q8 How many years have you been a member of your registered parish?

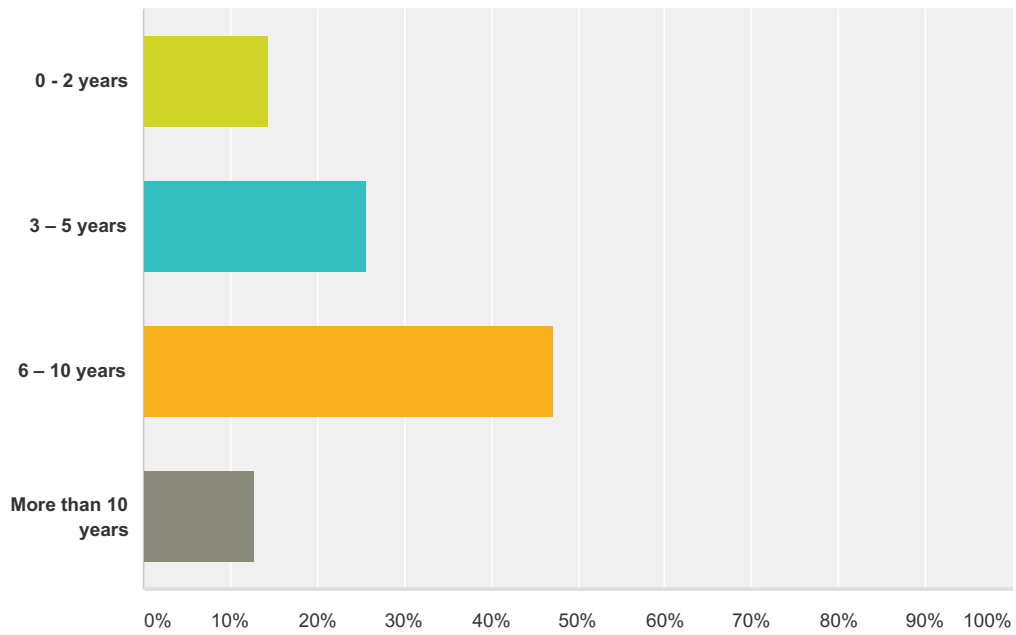
