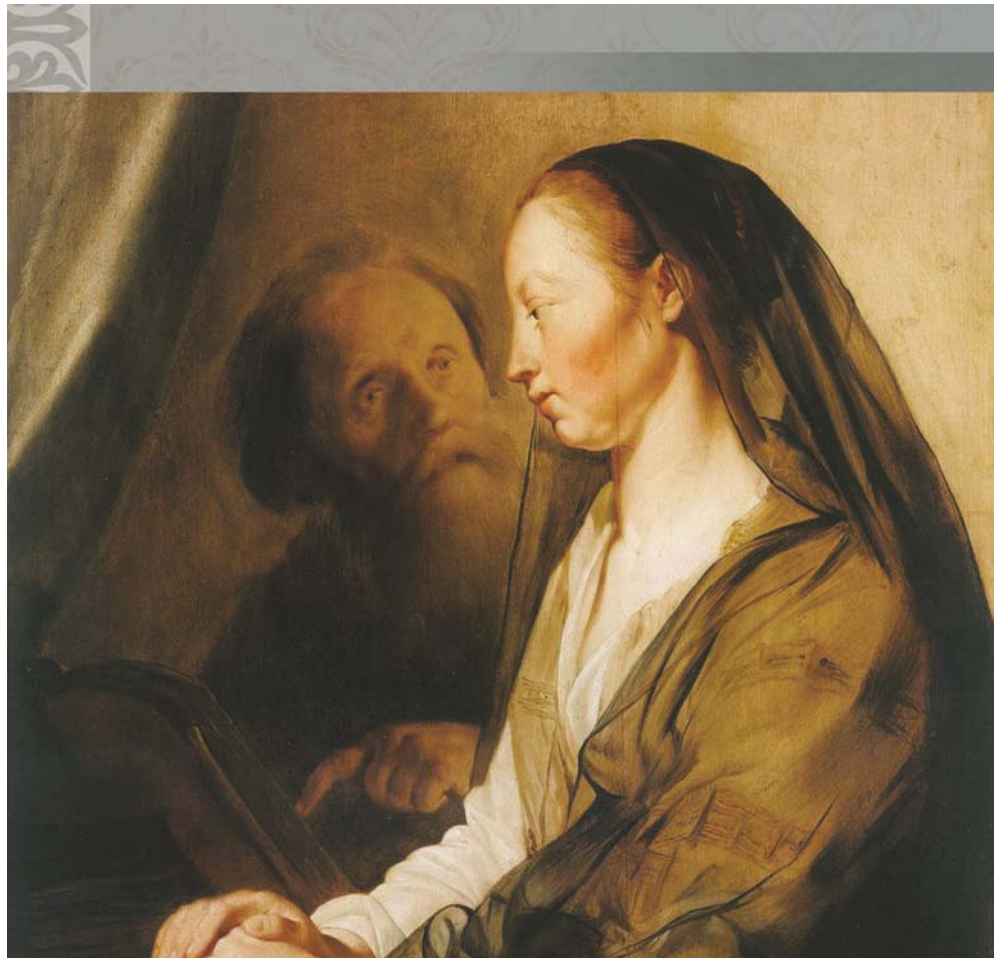

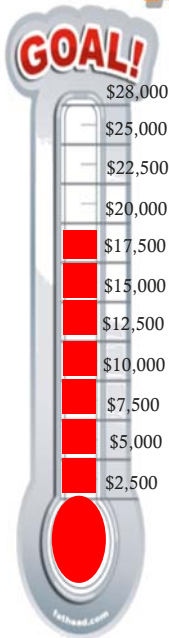

Evangelio según San Lucas 18,1-8.

Jesús enseñó con una parábola que era necesario orar siempre sin desanimarse:

"En una ciudad había un juez que no temía a Dios ni le importaban los hombres; y en la misma ciudad vivía una viuda que recurría a él, diciéndole: 'Te ruego que me hagas justicia contra mi adversario'.

Durante mucho tiempo el juez se negó, pero después dijo: 'Yo no temo a Dios ni me importan los hombres, pero como esta viuda me molesta, le haré justicia para que no venga continuamente a fastidiarme'".

Y el Señor dijo: "Oigan lo que dijo este juez injusto.

Y Dios, ¿no hará justicia a sus elegidos, que claman a él día y noche, aunque los haga esperar?"

Les aseguro que en un abrir y cerrar de ojos les hará justicia. Pero cuando venga el Hijo del hombre, ¿encontrará fe sobre la tierra?"

MEDITACIÓN EVANGÉLICO

La liturgia de este domingo se centra en la oración y en cómo no debemos desanimarnos jamás de orar ni de insistir a Dios con nuestras plegarias. El Papa Francisco nos ayuda con los siguientes consejos e insiste en la confianza que se debe tener al orar: *“Porque ninguna oración queda sin ser escuchada, muchas de nuestras oraciones no obtienen ningún resultado. ¿Cuántas veces hemos pedido y no hemos obtenido, llamado y encontrado una puerta cerrada? [Sin embargo], podemos estar seguros de que Dios responderá. La única incerteza se debe a los tiempos, pero no tenemos dudas de que Él responderá. Tal vez sea necesario insistir durante toda la vida, pero Él responderá. Nos lo ha prometido”*.

El relato de Jesús sobre la viuda y el juez afirma lo que el Papa Francisco nos asegura; Dios siempre escucha nuestros ruegos y da lo que conviene a la salvación de cada persona. *“¿Acaso Dios no hará justicia a sus elegidos si claman a él día y noche, mientras él deja que esperen? Yo les aseguro que les hará justicia.”* (Lucas 18:7-8). Reflexionar en la justicia en términos bíblicos es hablar de la misericordia infinita de Dios. Entonces, para crecer en justicia y misericordia los unos para con los otros, se necesita un profundo crecimiento en la vida de oración. Para un dialogo y encuentro profundo con Dios ¿qué se debe hacer? La Santa Teresa de Calcuta decía que: *“Sin un corazón lleno de amor y sin unas manos generosas, es imposible curar a un hombre enfermo de soledad. El amor es un fruto que madura en todas las estaciones y que se encuentra al alcance de todas las manos”*.

VIVIR LA LITURGIA

A medida que vivimos nuestra vida de fe, es fácil descorazonarse y perder la confianza en el poder y la presencia eficaz de Dios. Podemos caer en la apatía. Dada la inmensidad de las preocupaciones que abundan, nos sentimos impotentes y podemos perder la motivación para perseverar. Para combatir este cansancio, Jesús les dice a sus amigos que oren siempre. Persistir en la oración nos permite encontrar la determinación, la fuerza y la convicción para continuar en curso, incluso cuando se nos presenten dificultades. Si estamos decididos en nuestra búsqueda de Dios, eventualmente encontraremos a Dios atravesando nuestras tinieblas con la luz de su presencia, dándonos una visión contemplativa para que podamos ver como Él ve y amar como Él ama. Es solo cuando tomamos la persona de Cristo que podemos, con la ayuda de Dios, tocar el dolor y la soledad del mundo.
