Holy Trinity Altar Server Dress Code:

Attending Mass is a very special part of your week and dressing up is an important part of altar serving. All altar servers must strictly adhere to this dress code each and every time they serve. Thank you for serving!

Ladies: Dresses, skirts, dress slacks. Dressy tops. Dress socks, dress tights, hosiery in a neutral color may be worn. Dress shoes (must have closed heel or secure strap around the back of heel). Necklaces (if worn) are worn under vestments. Absolutely no shorts, no jeans of any color, no t-shirts, no mini-skirts, no mini-dresses, no form-fitting/midriff showing/low-cut tops.

Only post earrings may be worn (no large, flashy jewelry, no long/dangly earrings). Clear or neutral/natural shade of pink/peach/beige nail polish may be worn. Keep makeup (if worn) natural and to a minimum. Hair to be worn in a manner that will not tempt the server to play with, fix, or in any way adjust.

Gentlemen: Dress slacks (black, blue, grey, brown, or khaki) with dress belt. Collared dress shirt (short or long sleeved) tucked in. Dress shoes and dress socks. Hair neatly brushed/combed.

Ladies/Gentlemen: Holy Trinity School Mass Uniforms are acceptable. Please note, the following is **NOT ACCEPTABLE**: flip flops, slides (any shoe without a closed heel), tennis shoes, athletic shoes, and beach wear/sandals of any kind. In addition, absolutely no shorts, no jeans of any color and no t-shirts.

All Altar Servers will be required to comply with Holy Trinity's COVID-19 protocols. (1) If you are ill, please stay home. (2) Face mask required at all times. (3) Temperature checks upon arriving. (4) Hand sanitizer up arriving. (5) Hand sanitizer before and after handling of sacred vessels, setting up Altar, and prior to receiving Communion.
