FLUTE – Cleaning rod and cloth

CLARINET – Reeds* (strength varies; Vandoren brand recommended), cleaning swab, and cork grease

SAXOPHONE – Reeds* (strength varies, Vandoren brand recommended), cleaning swab, cork grease, and a neck strap

* Reeds will need to be replaced throughout the year.

TRUMPET/BARITONE/TUBA - Valve oil and slide grease

TROMBONE - Slide oil and slide grease

PERCUSSION – Bell Kit and Practice Pad with Stand, Snare Drum Sticks and Bell Mallets (these materials can be purchased together in a kit; see link below)
