CONNECTION TO CHRIST SMALL GROUPS Where our large church gets small!

Connection to Christ (C2C) small groups have been part of the fabric of our parish since 2013. During the Fall and Lenten seasons, we typically have 400 people—of whom about 130 are young adults—participating in groups.

In addition to helping members form friendships and grow in faith, a main focus of C2C is to "reach more". You don't have to be a parishioner, or even a Catholic, to be part of a



group. Participants are encouraged to invite family members, friends, coworkers, and neighbors to join their group or another group that better suits their needs.

Why Small Groups? That's what Jesus did! Yes, He spoke to the masses and fed thousands, but mostly He spent time with people in small groups (i.e. apostles) and in one-on-one encounters. That's how He formed disciples. Following "The Way" of Jesus, we know that C2C small groups, and providing one-on-one accompaniment, are key
