- **Greeting**—When you see someone you do not know, introduce yourself.
- **Parking**—If you can, consider parking offsite to leave more room in our parking lot for visitors unfamiliar with our parking lots (try walking, carpooling, using Uber or Lyft, or even riding a bike or scooter).
- **Seating**—If you arrive early, sit closer to the center aisle. Please arrive together, and do not save seats. By doing this, you will be leaving room for people coming after you to find a seat from the side aisles.

We invite you to do these things so that all who come to worship with us sense that “we are glad you are here, and we hope you come again.”
