**MORNING PRAYER - Chapel**

Morning prayer is a communal celebration of the church which includes the use of music, psalms and the Word. This beautiful service is about as long as a weekday Mass. The only Mass celebrated on Holy Thursday is in the evening.

The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery.

The single celebration of the Easter Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.

These holy days include additional rites celebrated once a year: the washing of feet, the veneration of the cross; the blessing of fire and water. These celebrations are unique and beautiful, and you are invited to be a part of them.
