Dieuseul Joseph is a 79 y/o man that lives with his niece Litha Louis, in the pitiful place you see in the "before" picture. She is the only one taking care of him. He has incontinence and urinary tract problems, causing him to have been recently hospitalized for several weeks. He has also spent some time at the Missionaries of charity to receive some help with cleanliness and hygiene. From the first days Haiti Mission teams arrived in Numero Deux, Mr Dieuseul has greeted us with a warm and welcoming smile. Although he is catholic and attends Mass regularly, for some reason he had never made his first communion. At the Easter vigil this year, he received communion for the first time. Mr. Joseph used to be a farmer, but now as previously stated, he lives with his kind and caring niece. Unfortunately, she suffered a stroke a few months ago which affected her ability to care for her uncle. By the grace of God, she is recovering slowly but surely. The HMI selection committee decided to build a new home in July 2019 for Mr. Dieuseul and his niece in order that they may have a healthier environment. They send their joyful thanks and prayerful love to all who have made this miracle come about.
