Mrs Adelson Calasse is seen in the “Before” picture with 2 of her 3 children. She is a 57 years old single mother who tries hard to raise her children and a grandchild. She sells fried foods in a little stand by the Numero Deux air strip (not far from where she lives in the community of Lot bo Terrain) to try to make a living for her family. She is not catholic but her daughter and one of her sons are and come to church when they can. For many years they have been praying for help in order to somehow get out of their crumbling shanty whose roof offered almost no protection from the torrential rains and Caribbean sun. They found themselves in a very bad condition. In June 2020 their prayer was answered. Because of the HMI family and the kindness of some of our donors, they found themselves moved from “hell to heaven” as they were blessed with one of the HMI “Haiti Castles” as they fondly refer to the new homes.
