CURRENT PROJECTS

HAITI MISSION, INC.

In 2000, I (along with my wife Faie), founded and currently direct a non-profit organization to bring safe and sufficient water supplies to the poor in the Jeremie region of Haiti. To date, a total of 70 water wells have been successfully drilled. The work there then extended to the building of simple yet very sturdy homes in order that families could have a decent place to live. As of July, 2020, a total of 193 homes have been built, with current plans to build 36 additional homes on an annual basis. In addition, to these humanitarian projects, there also has been initiatives to aid in education and animal husbandry. All of these efforts have been financed and supported by a group of generous benefactors as well as fund-raising activities conducted by dedicated volunteers.

COVID-19 CURE

At the present time, I am also involved in the process of distributing verifiable information on the pandemic now affecting the world.
