What a joy to meet a family that is in a pitiful situation, get to know them, visit with them and then be able to go back to dedicate and celebrate their new house. Another family out of the mud and misery and into a safe, solid and secure place to live. God willing, the Deitchmans will be back to dedicate and celebrate with the Lucs. Thanks to all who continue to support HMI and especially the house construction component through personal commitments and our Silent Auction annual fundraiser. Many, many people are hoping and praying that one day their family will receive the miracle of a new home.



2016 Haiti Mission Inc. Silent Auction Sponsorship Opportunities

Next year will be the 7th Annual HMI Silent Auction. By the grace of God and thanks to many generous donors, we have raised a total of \$271,390 over the past six years. In the first three years, contributions were utilized to help complete the Numero Deux School. For the past three years, we have dedicated all the silent auction money to our Home Building Project. Since July 2013, we have been able to build 43 homes and we are currently building two homes per month.

The homes cost \$7500 and we dedicate the silent auction money as a matching donation to build a home. So for every \$3750 donated to HMI for homes, we take \$3750 from Silent Auction proceeds to complete the funding. In order to reach our goal of building two homes per month we need a total of \$180,000 of which \$90,000 is needed from the Silent Auction.

Despite our fourth consecutive event rain out, we reached our goal last year of \$90,000, however, only approximately \$50,000 came from the sale of Silent Auction items. The balance came from many generous additional donors and the final \$9000 came from golf tournament fees.

We have been blessed to personally witness the impact these homes are having on the families of recipients, approximately 35 members of the construction team and the overall community. We hope to continue at the rate of two homes per month, but realistically we do not think we can rely only on the sale of silent auction items to raise the \$90,000 needed on an annual basis.

For that reason we have decided to try to raise at least half the money needed through sponsorship opportunities. We hope to raise a minimum of \$45,000 through sponsorships and the balance through the sale of silent auction items. Thanks to all of you who have helped us in the past. Your generous support has helped many poor families we serve. I would invite you to visit the HMI website and read about some of the home recipients and view the before and after pictures. Our goal is to lift one family at a time from misery to poverty, but we cannot do it without your help!
