Golf Tournament & Silent Auction Report

Silent Auction Report - Thank you and God bless you for your generosity! As most of you already know we had great weather for our 7th Annual Golf Tournament & Silent Auction. We had plenty of food, drinks and many teams enjoying their rounds on the beautiful Ellendale course. We received bids on over 100 items. As in the past, many winning bidders also added to their donation. After all the checks were collected, the auction items took in approximately **\$32,000**. We cannot begin to thank all who have helped. Many generous people have donated items for the past seven years and the bidders have continued to amaze us with their generosity! Thank you again!

Because of the generous support of our Sponsors prior to the event, donating just over \$83,000, our combined total reached **\$115,520** which is 10 % more than our original goal of \$105,000. **Our final total of \$115,520 will be restricted towards matching funds to continue to build the next 30 houses. We will be able to build an extra four houses over the next 12 months in addition to our regular two houses per month through May 2017!** Since the Silent Auction began dedicating money in 2013 to be utilized towards building homes we have raised \$329,345 in matching money. **You Cannot Out Give God!**

We already have donations in place to utilize the matching funds to build houses through the end of November 2016. **We are confident that donors will continue to support the building project and the matching money will not go unused which should allow us to build house #100 at the end of April 2017.** We have begun the process this month. Our local Haitian construction team is completing their **first successful attempt at building three houses in a month**. You will shortly be able to see and celebrate their success with pictures on the website and shared in the newsletter at the end of May. We hope to repeat that process three more months in the next year.



Laura and I head back to Haiti on December 28 – January 4, 2017 with a group of 14 to celebrate New Year's. It will be a blessing to be able to represent Haiti Mission and all of you, the supporters of HMI. We are looking forward to sharing the great news with the community that another 28 families will have the chance to move from misery to poverty over the next year because of your support! In addition, the joy will be extended to 35 families of the men who earn income each month from the construction project. As you know, our golf tournament is the platform that allows us to promote the work of HMI, invite people to come "pass a good time" and raise money to keep our wells flowing and teachers teaching in our schools. It was another wonderful year. Our sponsors and the team fees raised \$21,450. The "Tee Boxes" raised another incredible \$12,000! We received another \$15,000 in supplies, services, advertisement and other "in-kind" donations. The expenses came to right at \$10,000 so we ended up with \$23,000 to carry on our work of keeping the water flowing and the schools opened. What a blessing for the people we serve and a resounding statement of encouragement for the work we continue to do. There are many, many people to thank but a special thanks goes to Ellendale Country club and its staff for welcoming HMI and making us feel so much at home. May God bless them and bless everyone who helped in any way to make this year such a success.

In order to do that, our team would have to build three houses in four of the 12 months prior to April 2017. The stars aligned right during the month of May and we gave Fr. Joe the okay (and sent him the \$\$\$) to give it a try. Thanks be to God, they did it with a few days to spare. What an accomplishment for our construction team and what joy for the families who received a new house. So now we are at 75 homes total and we have 25 more to go to reach our goal. Because of the condition of the house and the health of his mother, the decision was made to build a house that would furnish Mrs. Poto a healthy and safe environment where she can spend the rest of her days.
