A quote from Davos this past year, from chef Jose Andres: "the underprivileged don't need your pity, they need your respect. The best way to show respect for the world's neediest individuals is to create opportunities for them to thrive".

This resonated with me as I think of how Haiti Mission Inc. (HMI) has supported the communities of Numero Deux and Ravine Sable over the past 20+ years – with the goal of creating opportunities for all Haitians to thrive, feel safe, loved, and with a sense of hope.

From home building, to education/teachers and medical staff, to food providers and drilling water wells – all of these responsibilities/jobs are filled by local Haitians. The transformation that has taken place in these areas of Haiti over the last 20 years is truly remarkable – the children of yesterday are now the builders/educators/medical staff of today.

Starpoint's solar lantern project is just one small part of this effort but we feel the lanterns provide additional opportunities for the families to thrive – through safety for women/children, ability to study at night in their homes, and more family time (and chores completed) as the sun sets and there is no electricity available.

The situation in Haiti remains extremely challenging and unsafe, but life does go on for these families. HMI has been able to continue to build 4 new homes a month and now has over 70 homes to be dedicated (Starpoint provides 2 lanterns for each new home). By the time HMI can return to Haiti later in 2024 there will be over 100 homes to dedicate – so we need lanterns! We also provide lanterns during the food/medicine distributions to over 650 local families.
