Mydukur is a very small town around where many day laborers work. All of them do manual labor either in the fields or as a domestic. Every day is a hard work in the hot sun. Everyday life in this area is challenging and fighting to keep safe as everyone is fearful of the coronavirus both for themselves and their children. At present they a three mile round trip walk to get drinking water at the nearby village. Working all day and arriving home in the late afternoon and then having to travel 3 miles for water is a hard thing to imagine.

The committee from our religious Society personally visited this village and advised that a borehole and well would be an incredible blessing to the people. I personally know this area and visited two years back when I went for vacation to India. Your help would be such a good thing for this community that has no way to fund a well.

Thank you Deacon Lloyd and all HAITI MISSION and OFI donors. I entrust you all into the hands of God for your kindness in furnishing fresh, potable water to these hard working people.
