There was literally nothing here when HMI built a pavilion, with a 3000 gallon water reservoir underneath it, to begin a school for the village children. This school now has the largest enrollment of the three villages with over 350 students attending regularly. Thanks to grants by two other groups, we now have in addition to the pavilion, a pre-K shelter and three block and mortar classrooms. We also have a well and a water line from the mountain spring furnishing water for these children.
