Well # 31 - Ravine Sable Well

The community of Ravine Sable is a true example of survival at its best. These families have never had their own water supply. Located in the middle of the two towns of Numero Deux and Bon bon, they are at least five miles from any major water source. A water line that HMI constructed several years ago to service the community is still subject to being disconnected whenever the volume of water flowing to the city of Jeremie drops to low. This well now greatly reduces the vulnerability of the families of Ravine Sable. It was another joyful moment in the mission of HMI when finally a permanent source of water was secured for our friends in Ravine Sable.



After seven years of supplying potable water to this remote community in Haiti, COVID-19 created a need for much more water. The hand pump process became overwhelmed. It was determined that the reservoir 135 feet below the surface could produce a much larger volume of water. We were able to secure funding to retrofit the well with a submersible pump, install a water cistern and supply a generator that resulted in a much greater volume of water being available. As you can see, this beautiful project was professionally done by our drill team. You can also see how blessed and appreciative are the community families.
