

Well #49 – Latiboliere – June 2016 – Dry hole

Latiboliere is a community to the East of Jeremie on the way to Port au Prince. The people there have never had a readily accessible water source. Our HMI drill team responded to their request for a well once HMI had received a grant from an anonymous donor. Unfortunately after drilling down to the maximum capabilities of our drill rig – 550 feet – we were not able to find any water. This is one of the most disappointing aspects of working in Haiti. No matter how hard one tries and how well intentioned, the realities and treacheries of nature become very apparent in many circumstances. Although the majority of our drill attempts are successful – thanks be to God – we always depart from these initiatives with a deep sense of disappointment and sadness. We leave knowing that we tried our best and asking God to somehow help these people because our efforts did not meet with success.
