

# Letter to Archbishop John Wester

## Confirmation Year II

The following is a guideline for writing your letter to Archbishop John Wester. The rough draft needs to be emailed to the Religious Education office on Wed, Feb. 12. Your paper will be reviewed and edited. If corrections are necessary, the letter will be returned to you. You will then need to make the corrections and return the final letter (via email) by Feb. 26. It is important for all letters be turned **in on time**.

**All letters must be submitted via email to the Religious Education office. Letter must be emailed to [REAssist@scpll.org](mailto:REAssist@scpll.org) or [anoriega@scpll.org](mailto:anoriega@scpll.org). If you do not get a reply saying that we received your letter, please call the office at 865-9370.**

Once the letters are received they will be printed and mailed to the Archbishop. The Archbishop does read all letters. It is important that you follow the guidelines below.

#### **YOUR LETTER NEEDS TO BE IN THE FOLLOWING FORMAT:**

Use size 12 font, single space, double space between paragraphs

**Paragraph 1:** Introduce yourself as a member of San Clemente Parish in Los Lunas who is preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

**Paragraph 2:** In your own words, tell the Archbishop why you want to be confirmed and what you like about being Catholic.

**Paragraph 3:** Tell the Archbishop how you are going to support the parish with your time and talents.

**Paragraph 4:** Specify which Saint you chose and why you chose them to be your Confirmation Saint. Be specific as to which Saint you chose as there are many Saints with the same name. Also, explain which virtues your Saint has and how you will imitate these virtues in your life today.

**Paragraph 5:** Tell whom you chose as your Sponsor and why you chose them.

**Paragraph 6:** Thank the Archbishop for the opportunity to be confirmed and let him know you will pray for him.
