

CONFIRMATION – Year I and Year II SERVICE HOUR REQUIREMENTS

2019-2020

All students enrolled in Confirmation are required to complete the following service hours:

COMMUNITY SERVICE-----10 hours	RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AIDE-----18 hours
CHURCH MINISTRY-----3 hours	PRO LIFE EVENT-----3 hours (Complete in Year I)

NOTE:

The hours in each category are the minimum hours required. Any hours over the minimum in one category will not be counted towards the hours required in other categories.

Confirmation Year I - All Service Hours must be completed and turned in by December, 2020

Confirmation Year II – All Service Hours must be completed and turned in by December 18, 2019

SERVICE HOURS

Community Service: 10 Hours

The Community Service Hours have three specific categories.

- (3 hours) Visiting the Sick- or those that are not able to care for themselves.** This category requires each student to visit one of our local Assisted Living/Nursing Homes and spend a minimum of 3 hours with the residents. The 3 hours of Community Service for Visiting the Sick are to be completed at one of the following locations:

- (3 hours) Poor in our community-** The 3 hours of Community Service to help the poor are to be completed at one of the following locations:

- (4 hours)Valencia Special Olympics or the Gabriel Project:**

4. (3 hours) Church Ministry:

Students are required to participate in a Church ministry at San Clemente. Students are encouraged to lector, usher, join the choir, etc. Other activities may include the parish picnic, fun run, fiestas, or other events. If you participate in a ministry that is during Mass, you must participate three times to receive credit.

(18 hours) Religious Education Aide:

Each student is required to assist in the Religious Education Department. You must choose one of the following options:

- a. Vacation Bible School – VBS will be for one week during the month of June. Students will be required to help from 8 a.m. - 12:30 p.m., Monday thru Friday for one week during the summer.
- b. Religious Education teacher aide –classroom assistant one semester for a total of 18 hours. Students will assist catechists on:
Monday evening (4 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. or 6 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.) or
Tuesday evening (6 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.)

Pro Life Event (to be completed in Year I)

All Confirmation Year I students are required to attend a Pro Life Day seminar in the first semester. This event will be held at San Clemente and will discuss the Sanctity of Human Life. At least one parent must attend with the student. The Pro Life event is Saturday, September 28, 2019 (9am-11:30am)
