

**Saint Paper Guidelines**  
**Confirmation Year II**  
**2018-2019**

Our Archbishop John Wester asks each Confirmation candidate to “carefully study a variety of saints before you make a decision on which Saint’s name you will choose. The Saint you choose should be one that you can look to as a role model and pray to for guidance and for intercession.”

The paper should be at least **two typed full** pages in length, double-spaced using size 12 font (no exception), one-inch margins on top, bottom, left and right sides (no wider). Print should be Times New Roman or Arial font.

This paper must be written in your own words. Do not copy and paste from books or websites.

Your paper should follow the following format:

1/3—A biography of the saint you have selected.

1/3—Why you selected this saint and why you would like to use this saint for your Confirmation name. Explain how this saint can be a role model for you.

1/3—How you think the practice of selecting a name at Confirmation will help you in the future.

Saint papers are due on Wednesday, January 23, 2019. They are to be handed in during class.
